

The music of award-winning composer Alexander Liebermann has been performed in Europe, North & South America, and Asia by renowned artists, ensembles, and orchestras such as the Nice Philharmonic, the Deutsche Oper Berlin, and the Stradivari-Soloists with members of the Berlin Philharmonic.
